

# HOW TO APPLY FOR 100 CLUB OF ILLINOIS LICENSE PLATE:

- Complete the “100 Club of Illinois License Plate Application” PDF found on the 100 Club’s website:

## FAQs:

- **What does the 100 Club of Illinois license plate look like?**
  - The 100 Club of Illinois license plate will be an IL Universal Plate with a decal that you will adhere to the plate. See below:



- **When will I receive my decals?**
  - Decals will not be mailed until 2,000 applications have been received for the 100 Club of Illinois. If your license plates are expiring, you will need to renew your current plate registration. The 100 Club of Illinois and Secretary of State will send out notification once 2,000 applications have been received and production on the specialty plates has begun.
- **Can I adhere the 100 Club of Illinois decal to any license plate?**
  - No. Decals can only be adhered to an IL Universal Plate. You will receive your IL Universal Plate and 100 Club of Illinois decals after 2,000 applications have been received.
- **What size is the decal?**
  - There are two sizes – one that will fit a standard size registration plate and one that will fit a motorcycle size registration plate.
- **What does the non-refundable fee cover?**
  - The non-refundable fee covers costs associated with the license plate taken on by the 100 Club of Illinois, including producing and shipping the decals. The remaining amount will be donated to the 100 Club of Illinois General Fund to support the Club’s mission of providing for families of fallen first responders and active duty first responders across Illinois.
